

CAP.5 / CAP-1 12 Volt Capacitors Installation:

Turn-on Terminal

CAP Installation:

- Mount CAP as close to the amplifier as possible.
- Maximum CAP-1 terminal torque is 50 inch lbs. or 6mm.
 Maximum CAP.5 terminal torque is 20 inch lbs. or 1.6mm.
- Use heavy positive and negative cables with heavy duty 1/4 in. terminals for the CAP posts. Do not drill through CAP body or block vent hole.
- Be sure to observe proper polarity when connecting cables!
 Reverse polarity connection will damage the CAP and void the warranty!
- Connect the ground terminal.
- Turn on the head unit and touch the audio system turn-on wire to the square touch pad on the top of the CAP. Voltage will climb as the CAP charges.
- After the charge voltage climbs to at least 8 volts, the trigger wire may be removed. Permanently connect turn-on wire to terminal marked "T".
- Connect cable from positive terminal on CAP to positive connection on amp. Connect negative cable from CAP to negative connection on amp.
